



VoiceMail Operations

Access the voicemail System

- From your handset, press the Messages key, or dial *95
- Enter your PIN code to access your secure voicemail

Listening to voicemails

- First, log into the voicemail system (as above)
- Press 1 To listen to the voicemail messages, then
 - 3 - Advanced options
 - 3 - Envelope
 - * - Return to Main Menu
 - 4 - Play previous message
 - 5 - Repeat current message
 - 6 - Play next message
 - 7 - Delete current message
 - 9 - Save message in a folder
 - 0 - Save in New Messages
 - 1 - Save in Old Messages
- * - Help – or during message playback, this will rewind the message.
- # - Exit – Or, during playback, this will skip forward

Navigating Voicemail Folders

Once logged in, press “2” to change folders, then:

- 0 - Switch to New Messages
- 1 - Switch to Old Messages
- 2 - Switch to Work Messages
- 3 - Switch to Family Messages
- 4 - Switch to Friends Messages

Changing Your Voicemail Greetings & Password

- First, log into the voicemail system (as above)
- Press “0” for mailbox Options and then press:
 1. Record your unavailable message
 2. Record your busy message
 3. Record your name
 4. Record a temporary message
 5. Change your password

Disable your voicemail box temporarily

Dial *950 from you handset to deactivate and activate the voicemail service on your extension.

Additional Management Functions

Transferring Calls

- **Warm or Attended Transfer of a call**
 - Press the “Transfer” key
 - This immediately puts your call on hold
 - Dial the recipient of the transfer
 - Hit send
 - Once the recipient picks up and chooses to accept the call, press the “Transfer” key again.
 - If the recipient refuses the call, press the “Cancel” key to pick up the original call.
- **Blind or Unattended Transfer of a call**
 - Press the “Transfer” Key
 - This immediately puts your call on hold
 - Dial the recipient of the transfer
 - Hit send
 - Immediately press “Transfer” again.
- **Dial or Transfer to Voicemail**

Dialing directly to someone’s voicemail is done by prepending “*95” to their extension number; to dial the voicemail of extension 210, dial *95210 .

 - Press the “Transfer” Key
 - This immediately puts your call on hold
 - Dial *95 and the extension of the recipient, for example, *95210.
 - Hit send
 - Immediately press “Transfer” again.

Do Not Disturb

Press the “dnd” key to toggle silent rejection of calls.

Call Forwarding

- Press the “Forward” key
- Press “1” for always forward, “2” to forward only if you are away from the phone, or press “3” to only forward when you are busy.
- Enter the number to forward your calls to
- Press enable or save to enable the forward.
- Repeat the steps above to disable forwarding.

Call Recording

If toggle-able call recording is available on your extension, press “*1” to begin recording.
